Old Business:

- Baronial Coronets
 - Maintenance has been completed, they are looking fantastic.
 - 3rd set-padding, Morgain and Glinnis are helping with this (June 1)
- Seagirt Pavilion Storage- (May 2021)
 - Stored for the moment, will be moved in post COVID-19 times.
 - Pavilion poles
 - Need measurements for spike length – Magnus will create the caps; currently unable to access due to COVID.

- Tapestry Loan Rules (May 2021) - a pending discussion. Perhaps a separate meeting is in order.
- Seagirt award badges resubmissions for returned items (Iago)
 - Silver Whale has permission to conflict, pending approval.
- Finishing list field stantians, rope attaching (May 2021)
 - Posts currently with Adalwolf, to be followed up on.
- Equipment rentals – (May 2021)
 - Separate discussion pending. Is it possible to rent feast gear and kitchen equipment, and would it be more financially feasible than storing the existing equipment? Research to follow.
- Concrete rules for what can and cannot be posted on Seagirt Forum page needs to be decided on. (July 2021)
 - Trial run solution:
 - “Monthly Market Days” where the comments of a single post could be utilized to advertise sales/shops/etc
 - Reinvent the Buy & Sell page to allow for LOCAL artisans and LOCAL SCA related items on sale, etc
 - Group order posts still allowed, provided there is only 1 post per “topic”
 - ONE post in the forum may be permitted to reference a sale/item in the Buy & Sell.
 - Official rules to be posted in Forum/Buy & Sell soon.

New Business:

- A funding proposal for new targets has been put forth. Proposal was posted to the forum page for discussion. Requested \$1400 for the purchase of 4 Egertec brand straw mats.
 - Motion: Make a committee to investigate alternative and more affordable target options.
 - Motion passed, to revisit during October Curia. Greta to head up a team to investigate options.
