- The PEPP talk has been set for two weeks from tonight, January 17, 2017
- With a busy schedule over the Christmas holiday Julianna isn't done her reports from the event, but should have them ready tomorrow.
- Council looked at dates for the upcoming Yule and a consensus was reached for December 3 and a fee will be given to New Horizon Centre to hold said date.
- Tatiana suggests: We should look at setting up an account for the TUTR funds raised in the barony. We can use these funds for future events we hold in the barony. Council talked about the pros / cons of having an account versus a line in the budget, also the difference between TUTR event and TUTR classes at an event.
 - Consensus was made on a fund and naming it the "Education Fund". This name will differentiate it for multiple education purposes and not just for TUTR classes.

Gentle Arts 2017 – Isabella da Firenze

 - the reduction of site rental, then putting the difference equally into prizes and emergency.
 - Adjusting the estimated attendance from 50 adults to 40 adults.

Old Business

Event Signs – Caieya

We would like to see a bigger sign on the highway for Seagirt events. It has come to our attention that at previous events the current signs were not seen on the highway. We have asked that another two signs be made large enough to be seen by fast moving vehicles.

- Caieya has suggested if we go bigger we should look at purchasing a more sturdy material.
- We have asked for holes closer to the middle for better functionality on different size poles and signs.
- The total cost of the above two bullets are:
 - \$15 for sturdier sign board,
 - \$40 for reflective tape,
 - \$100 for additional signboard
 - Council reached agreement by consensus.
- In addition, Caieya has asked if anyone has a 12' Cricket Cutter they may use. Elina volunteered hers.

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New Business

Daffodil 2018 – Moving the Date

Council has talked about moving the date to a time that would conflict less with other events. This being one of our premier events we would like to see as many people come as possible, this includes all Royalty. After looking through the Kingdom Calendar and discussing different dates, the Council consensus was to leave the date as it is for net year, 2018

Any Other Business

University of Ithra – Insula Magna (Anna-Jane)

When TUTOR took off Insula Magna Ithra Campus became inactive in 2008. (They are both Universities). Chancellor and Bursar (Exchequer) agreed that the money in the account would not be transferred to Ithra headquarters. The account was finally closed January 3, 2017. Bank had deducted \$160 for dormant account fees for the 8 years that the account was inactive, leaving a balance of \$310.15 in the account. Ithra Campus Financial Committee agreed that the Funds should be split between the active branches of Insula Magna based on what each branch had contributed in 2007 to 2008: False Islae 47%, Hartwood 32%, Seagirt 21%. Seagirt's share is \$65.13 which will go into the new Education Fund.

While reports were being given by officers, a few points of interests were announced;

- We need to follow the Customary guidelines (as best we can) when our office term is up or when one needs to end it sooner.
- Facebook is our official means of communication. We need to use this resource to ensure that the populace have the chance to hear about office openings. We also have agreed to continue using the Rocks email list for important notices.
- When you are thinking about taking on an officer's position, make sure you have an up to date paid membership.

Archery report:

One practice in November. Many people otherwise busy. Sir Andras Truemark came up and coached, and several of the new-ish archers came out (as well as several regulars).

Several archers received new rankings this year! Tokens and tassels for these were given out at Yule. Also, the 50th year archery coins have arrived (thanks to Tatiana for bringing them up), and are starting to make their way to their recipients. Those who shot competitively in Seagirt events this last summer have earned a coin. Shoots such as the Lady and the Templars shoot, the Baronial Championship, etc. are included. One coin per person. Coins will be with me at practice and at council, and any Allthings I attend.

Also, I'm offering an introduction to making period nocks and fletching at the Gentle Arts event in January! The current Principality Champion, Arcos Thomas of Appledore, expressed a desire to see more period equipment being used competitively on the field. I would like to encourage everyone to come learn (one way) to make period arrows. There are lots of techniques, so I'll be handing down

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what I was taught by my Arcos, along with some other assorted information I've collected. If anyone has very small hacksaws with fine teeth they could bring, that would be helpful, as I only have one.

With Yule over but the weather getting cold and icky, it is the season for maintenance. I brought a fletching jig to Allthing and some arrows were worked on a bit. Not much planned for December due to most people having busy schedules. I will bring a fletching jig and glue to any Allthings I can attend. Look for equipment making days in January. Please let me know if you need assistance in ordering parts: I have heard general ideas about needing to do another order.

Inventory of archery stuff will need to be done.

Also, my term as branch archery marshal is up! I would like to invite submissions for the position to be submitted at _____(month)council. Sr and Jr TAMs may apply. Council will then vote on a replacement. I'll work with whoever takes over to ensure that things transfer over well. I've been preparing spares of some things (archery tokens, etc) for a while to make sure that whoever comes after me is well supplied.

Thrown report:

Everyone has been busy with Yule prep and life. So far still in the "getting enough equipment to do the things" stage.

Talked to Sarah Miles about procuring rounds: arranging a time to pick up wood as time and vehicles allow. Talked to Drew Coupar, who intends to make and donate two stands and donate an axe. Timeline dependent on life. Talked to Seamus who has some ideas for other gear too.

- Looking for copper rivets to replace plastic ones. Wulgar responded that he has some.
- Targets for bothe Archery and Thrown weapons in progress.

Minister of Arts and Sciences – Elinor Holgrove (February 2017)
