 - We had only one thrown weapons practice in December due to holidays, but still threw!
 - The Thrown Weapons Inter-Kingdom Challenge closed December 31, 2018. I would like to congratulate the following throwers who have achieved a rank in the top 10 in the Thrown Weapons Inter-Kingdom Challenge in the knife category:
 - Saito: 2nd
 - Isabella da Firenze: 5th
 - Athelina Grey: 8th
 - Saito's score also contributes to An Tir winning the TWIKC in the team competition for knife.
 - The TWIKC involves throwing at a wider range of distances than the current royal round format. Throwing from 15 and 20 foot distances in addition to the 10 foot "standard" requires both more power and significantly more control: but I find it entertaining to give it a shot whether I stick anything or not! I encourage everyone to try throwing a TWIKC in the 2019 year.
 - On this year's wish list:
 - fancier spear with a slightly broader blade.

Scribal preparation for March's Daffodil Tournament is well underway. If Their Excellencies Seagirt have any more awards they intend to give out at Daffodil they should get them to their Scribe as soon as possible, please!

Prep for the new Orca charter has also started, also aiming for Daffodil release for that one.

Not mentioned in last month's report but finished over December were eighteen individualized invitations to Daffodil, one to TRM An Tir, one each to TRH Tir Righ & TRH Summits, and one to every single Baronial Coronet in the entire Kingdom of An Tir. Seamus requested these as Daffodil Steward, wording by (I believe) Master James, and I wound up doing them on the computer due to the workload. I believe these were delivered to their various recipients at Ursalmas.

I've also gotten the Office365 tools available to the Scribal account set up in a way I believe will be useful to myself and to my eventual successors in this office.

These include, so far:

- an Excel sheet with a record of all award production since I took this office, recording event, recipient, type/name of award, and who contributed what to that award (calligraphy, illumination, wordsmithing, etc)
- the start of a "Seagirt Scribal Who's Who" so I can keep notes as to who is able/available/skilled in various things. Also an Excel sheet.
- using the OneNote app for event planning, random notes, saved URLs and other resources, and such

- starting to look into the Forms app as a possible data-collection survey to further populate the "Who's Who" spreadsheet.
- a fully digitized Seagirt Book of Scribe as an O365 Word doc, with additional wordings and resources already accumulating over the paper-only version I inherited.

My SCA membership is due to expire end of April 2019; I'll get it renewed before then and send our Seneschal my updated membership information.

I'm also going to be off work for about a week in mid-February for minor surgery; I'm hoping after the good drugs wear off to have lots of that week to sit nice and still at my desk and do all the scribal things...

I have just taken over the position of Branch Archery Marshal from Aniko and am just getting things sorted out.

There have been no incidents to report.

We've started shooting in Saanich at Percival Christianson's farm. We have set up 2 targets at 20 yards in a covered and lit barn, and have since had two weekday evening practices in January (there were 6 people at the first practice, but only myself and Percival at the second practice). We're still fine tuning the set-up (e.g., lighting is poor so we have a spotlight, we need an easier way to put up the netting in the back, we need to set up bow-stands, and figure out how to keep the kitty off the range!). I would also like to work on another target that is more suitable for lighter bows (less than 30 pounds), as we have bounce-outs using the current targets. I'm hoping to start the Principality seasonal shoot next practice (Thurs Jan 31).

There has been some interest in shooting at the farm in Metchosin in February (spearheaded by Athelina), but that will depend on weather and interest.

I’m thinking we contact Asa Martel in Hartwood for a quote to replace all the “pearls” with real fresh water pearls and mount them correctly. If I recall he had once said \$75 each but I could be wrong.

A new court heralds tabard is in the works Runa has been working hard to have it done for daffodil. This was made with repurposed fabric found in Seagirt stores during the great purge so no cost to the barony.

Post-Daffodil shoot was well attended with 19 shooters. Minor incident where a bow shattered. No injuries and the bow was inspected by the Archos beforehand.

There have been a few shoots at Jarrod's, but with the poor lighting inside the barn and schedule issues, I will stop running shoots there and focus on Metchosin. Athelina has expressed interest in potentially shooting there in future.

We've chosen a Sunday schedule to allow people to go to thrown weapons (10am), archery (12pm), and fight practice (2pm), and we'll see how this pans out for April. So far it has been well attended (avg 10 archers) but there might be time issues for fighters. Also will suggest moving archery to 1230 to allow throwers to finish.

I will be adding a Saturday morning shoot (10:30) at the Metchosin farm. Another outdoor shooting location would be ideal (Saanich?). I will investigate the possibility of using Tammy's land off the Malahat as she has 12 acres and is interested in archery.

I got the pattern and specs for making the SST quiver and will start looking for and pricing out leather.

The archery target stands and butts are in rough shape. Two stands have already been built, with one new target butt already made and two more being made. Other stands should be replaced as they are falling apart. It cost ~\$30 for supplies for one target stand using 2x4s and bolts. I will enquire about the archery fund and what would be available for replacing aging stands. Currently new target butts are being made out of rolled cardboard acquired for free.

• **Thrown Weapons – Athelina Grey 2016-06-01**

Thrown weapons report:

Average # participants: 5 - 12

Average # marshals: 3, plus one or two "in training".

-Practices have been happening in Metchosin on Sundays!

-More people have been attending since we moved thrown to before archery on Sundays. However, this means we now don't have enough targets for the number of people who want to participate!

The range space is not big enough for both ranges to run at the same time if archers are wanting to shoot at anything longer than 20 yards while TW was happening. There is enough space for a thrown range to be open with more than the required safety margin (25feet) at the back of the Thrown Weapons range before the usual 20 yard line - we could consider archers warming up at 15 or 20 yards (shooting from the 20 yard line to the 40 yard target) while TW people finish their Royal Rounds, as long as they did not wander around: very clear range markings would be necessary and this option would only work if there were a significant number of both thrown and archery marshals willing to help marshal.

But we still need more thrown targets even if we try the double range.

Therefore, since I donated the last two stands out of my pocket, I'd like to request either of the following:

a) funds to make another tank stand. ~\$100. (low estimate) **WE HAVE \$97 APPROVED IN FUNDS.**

b) someone who isn't me to arrange to cut some rounds to put on our less tanky but more portable tripods. Rounds need to be about 10" thick, and need to have space for a 14" diameter circle to be drawn on them with room around the edge. Call it 16" diameter minimum. I don't have the tools or skills to do this. Jaime might have a chain saw... and James might have a tree?

Rounds don't last anywhere near as long as the tank stands, but can be a bit more portable if they are not too thick. There's a balance between "thick enough that Wulfie doesn't chop it in half the first time he hits it" and "I can't carry it". 🤔

-Wulfgar very kindly mended one of our tank targets, and Isabella is arranging to have wood cut to spruce it up a bit more. (Wood donated by Robyn Jutras, an occasional thrower).
-a few more people are expressing interest in being Jr TW marshals and we've all been taking turns helping to keep things running as smooth as we can.
-I'm still waiting for my Sr TW Marshal paperwork to go through - it has been found though, now that Howard is all set up as Principality Thrown Weapons Marshal! Yay!
-We're starting to plan out which events Jr marshals will be able to work with Sr Marshals at in order to get event range experience required to become Sr Marshals.
-I encourage Event Stewards to include "how to transport Thrown Weapons and Archery range equipment to the event" in their bid budget. It usually takes a full pickup truck bed for archery and another half to full bed for thrown. This means either multiple trips / lots of gas, or getting a trailer and hauling it (fewer trips, still lots of gas, potentially equipment rental). Sometimes we band together to bring what we can, but often we (or kind volunteers) end up having to make many trips to and from site to haul things. I don't know many people who have room for both their own gear and a bunch of targets.
-Jarrod (Percival) offered to let us throw at his place as well as an added bonus throwing venue (dependent on his schedule).

Anyhoo, yay for more throwing things!

Side note: the door on the outhouse has shifted a tiny bit so it doesn't lock shut any more. Must shift lock to new place.

- Seagirt has setup a new Facebook group for Inclusion, Accessibility and Diversity discussion. Please give us your feedback.

Over the past many months, we have counseled people to temper their interaction with others and to be mindful when dealing with personal issues. In particular, dealings in the imperfect world of online communications where body language and nuance has no place. We encourage people to seek ways to correct interpersonal issues through personal contact and mediators before jumping to impersonal methods. We also encourage people to follow the An Tir grievance procedure whenever possible in an effort to return relationships to a normalized state before damage is irreparably done.

We also encourage people to remember that the SCA is a society that was created based upon the ideals of chivalry and honour.

It was thus that we were saddened to hear that people were making secret recordings of our council meetings and that at least one person was utilizing these recordings to disparage our Barony and myself as well.

The issue of these recordings has been mulled over this past month by representatives from the Principality, the Kingdom and a discussion was even held with the RCMP regarding the legalities of it.

First, Mistress Lenora has words from the Kingdom.

Greetings unto the Barony of Seagirt.

It has come to our attention that Baronial Council meetings have been recorded without the knowledge or consent of meeting attendees. Recording attendees under these circumstances is not in keeping with the goals of honour and chivalry we hold within the Society.

Meeting minutes (or notes) are the live written record of a meeting, not legal documents. Meeting minutes generally include but are not limited to: the list of attendees, agenda items, important business discussed, decisions made, and action items including those responsible and due dates. Simply, the notes of the meeting should describe decisions made by the branch.

The publication of those meeting notes should be made according to your branch's traditions and customs.

Branch business meetings are public and anyone may attend. If there are members who are interested in the monthly meeting but unable to attend, perhaps talk to the baronial officers and see if setting up Skype is possible. This is done in some branches where an officer or member may have to travel a distance to attend.

As for the legalities of the recordings, the person using them to disparage us has been citing Criminal code 184 where an individual may record another without their knowledge during conversations they have had. Some may have heard of this in a recent federal case. While this act may indeed be legal it does not apply to a business meeting where there are more than the two principals involved. The RCMP however, have stated that the current state is a gray area as we have no previous policy in place for such recordings.

Thus, Their Excellencies, after consulting with their seneschal have amended the baronial Customary as follows:

“4.11 No activities at Seagirtian events may be recorded in any medium without first notifying people who may be involved that it is being done such that they may opt out of any such recording if they choose to do so.”

This would apply to someone recording council, videoing fight practice or filming at events.

Also, regarding the customary, I'd like all officers to review their pertinent sections and to suggest proposals for changes for next council.

Finally, given recent actions being taken by individuals to undermine my position, I can't help wonder that a segment of the population of this barony may have lost confidence in my ability to continue as seneschal. Thus, I would now ask this council to either re-affirm me in this position or to let me know otherwise such that I can step aside and someone else can carry out the duties of this office.

• **B&B Update: Baroness Lucy Holgrove & Baron Edward Holgrove 2018-08**

There has been a lot of change for us here in Seagirt over the past year. Not just the change of coronets. The very nature of the SCA can appear to be changing. The drive to make the SCA more inclusive has meant we are finally addressing issues of safety and openness that made The Society seem less welcoming than it once was. The Society I joined in AS 20 was a place where I was told all were welcome. A place where defence of the weak was a part of a chivalrous ideal. A place where differences were to be celebrated and cause for excited conversations as we all strove to learn about each other's discoveries and experiences. That place is still here, if we believe in it. If we are willing to rise up and defend it. Treating each other with courtesy and respect has always been at the core of the Society. Things like bullying and harassment policies are just tools to protect, preserve and defend those ideals. The final shoot was the Champions Team shoot, which consisted of three archers per team (from each of the categories of recurve, longbow, and crossbow). The head-to-head shoot was quick and brutal, with Lions Gate emerging as victors, placing them in the lead and taking the archery war point. The Sunday Fun Shoot was a great way to end the event. Extra thanks to Aniko and Thomas of Appledore for donating prizes, James for moving the targets to and from site, and all the marshalling help we received!
