We went to Lions Gate and Hartwood events. Both events were well attended by Seagirtians and that was fantastic. We were part of both Lions Gate's and Hartwood's court. We are

looking forward to seeing more event bids come forward with creative and fun ways to celebrate as a group. Congrats to everyone who won and helped at both events! You are awesome!

As many of you are aware we have a disagreement that has caused quite a divide in our Barony. We both believe the solution starts with everyone taking a step back and understanding that both words and actions towards each other are hugely impactful and it's important that we all handle disagreements with grace and kindness.

We have many people who serve and freely give of their time to Seagirt and we are strong because of them. We work together and play together and it's heartbreaking to both of us that factions are drawn and terms such as "gatekeeping" are being used, in our Barony and Principality, to describe the divisive situation over the targets.

To move forward together, we need to stop speaking negatively about each other. We need to try and understand where both sides are coming from, a desire to beautify and improve the game and concern that this will financially overextend the Baronies coffers. We believe that both sides are attempt to express themselves with the best of intentions but frustration can sometimes bring out words that are hurtful.

When new targets were made and donated to the archery community in an effort to be supportive, the feedback received (not from the Baronial Archer) was that it appeared to be undermining of the office. It was never the intention, and at the heart of it, intention is very important to consider in whatever actions someone undertakes.

We want to believe that everyone here has the good of the Barony at the core of their intentions and we need to work together to understand each other when we don't agree. We need impassioned people, for sure, but if we let that passion get ahead of our obligation to be kind to each other, we are lost. We need to look at all members' intentions with understanding and lifting each other up. We all share very similar interests and it should be easy enough to find common ground.

Kingdom has looked at our finances at the request of our exchequer and they have stated that, "... (they) are concerned about the amount that the expense will reduce (y)our operating funds..." and they have advised us to consider the expense and defer this investment, at least until events start up again and income starts flowing.

I have finished my work on mending and rematching straggles of loaner arrows. We have many "sets" of arrows available for loan now, come out and use them!

The inventory of the range is still an open project.

The committee I headed for investigating the options for archery targets moving forward in Seagirt has concluded. The document containing information on various target types has been published on the forum, and I hope people will find it of some interest and help. Our committee recommendation to Seagirt was decided by a vote with Egertec straw mats coming in first place, the stacked cardboard model in second place, and the rolled cardboard type of target in third. Discussion of the recommendation I expect will be set for the "old business" section of this council. Thank you to everyone who contributed to the committee!

On a final note, pandemic regulations are ever changing. Please keep an eye out on what's being put in place to avoid ending up at a practice without the requirements

for attendance. The Seneschal will be the best person to ask general questions on how any new SCA regulations will affect local activities.

Old Business:

- Baronial Coronets
 - Maintenance has been completed, they are looking fantastic.
 - 3rd set-padding, Morgaine and Glinnis are helping with this (June 1)
- Seagirt Pavilion Storage- (May 2021)
 - Stored!
 - Wulfgar willing and able to carry out repairs as necessary, just need to be assessed.
 - Longer support lines needed to properly secure the pavilion so it no longer threatens to collapse on everyone.
- Tapestry Loan Rules (May 2021) - a pending discussion. Perhaps a separate meeting is in order.
- Finishing list field stantians, rope attaching (May 2021)
 - Posts currently with Adalwolf, to be followed up on.

- Equipment rentals – (May 2021)
 - Separate discussion pending. Is it possible to rent feast gear and kitchen equipment, and would it be more financially feasible than storing the existing equipment? Research to follow.
- Concrete rules for what can and cannot be posted on Seagirt Forum page needs to be decided on. (July 2021)
 - Trial run solution:
 - “Monthly Market Days” where the comments of a single post could be utilized to advertise sales/shops/etc
 - Reinvent the Buy & Sell page to allow for LOCAL artisans and LOCAL SCA related items on sale, etc
 - Group order posts still allowed, provided there is only 1 post per “topic”
 - ONE post in the forum may be permitted to reference a sale/item in the Buy & Sell.
 - Official rules to be posted in Forum/Buy & Sell soon.
- New Archery target committee:
 - Kingdom has concerns of the financial strain the Egertec straw mats might have on the Barony in lieu of COVID-19 and the lack of income from events.
 - General decision for now: Reach out to other branches to potentially split shipping costs to a contact in the States for pick up sometime in Jan. Will revisit. (October 2021)
- Isabel de la Roche, lending library: creating a library of tools and equipment for various crafts within the SCA for people to borrow. Isabel and Roza to hammer out details and set things up!

New Business:

- Potentially in the future: May we take ONE of the three sets of coronets (the flat sided ones in need of repair) and give them to Hartwood if they make it to Barony? Decision to be made later and pending Hartwood’s road to Barony, but it is something to keep in mind.
