Since last month this is what has happened with the Seagirt Tapestry project. 14 meters of beige fabric has been purchased for a cost of \$147.00. The fabric has been cut into 12 panels with enough fabric left on the bolt for 3 or 4 more panels if needed. 10 of the panels as well as the rough draft roll of paper have gone to Leslie who is distributing it to the others who have volunteered to draw. They will also transfer the designs to the fabric. The first panel is finished to the point of joining it to the next panel. James has the second panel and design. He is transferring the design to the fabric. The tapestry wool has been divided up and is ready to go out to the stitchers with the panels when they are ready. I will be returning the original tapestry panel and two fabric pieces (one linen and one navy) to Runa to go back into storage. The remaining new fabric and yarn I will keep until they are needed.

Progress is still continuing to be made on the Seagirt tapestry. And samples of work being done are showing up on our Seagirt Tapestry page huzzah! However, there has been a further development. Upon closer inspection of the current tapestry already made it has been found that the backing fabric was not a good match for the tapestry. There are a few places where the dye from the navy blue backing is bleeding through into the front fabric. As well the back fabric material is too heavy, its tearing away from the front panels and causing damage. Lina Grantham has experience restoring textile pieces with museums and I agree with her assessment that the backing fabric should be carefully removed from the current tapestry and replaced with a much lighter material. She suggests a light weight cotton, like muslin. If we are wanting to display this without further damage to the current tapestry we will need to, remove the current backing, purchase new backing material both for the current tap and upcoming panels, and change how we hang it as the current hooks are also tearing the fabric.

As I currently live a block over from my locker where the tapestry is, I can easily take care of the removal of the backing fabric. I have LOTS of experience in carefully picking out seams, a skill I'm sure many crafters grudgingly acquire.... The backing fabric which is quite sturdy could be re-purposed into fabric for garb, or donated to one of our next fundraisers.

for volunteering to take part in this. We plan to have something to present at the next council in October.

This office has been asked to look for indoor sites for a winter range. If you have any leads on such a location, please let me know! I expect both finding and operating a covered site to be more challenging given the pandemic, but even if we don't end up being able to utilize the space this year, it would be great for the Barony to have something set up for going forward. Sheltered but not walled may be easiest pandemic-wise.

The Branch Marshal has made a request for the Thrown Weapons and Archery practices to be held concurrently instead of sequentially. We have investigated and concluded this is not feasible at this time. We currently lack both the available space at the range site and the volunteer resources to run both separately instead of doubling up jobs to run them back to back.

The Branch Marshal has made a request for Thrown Weapons and Archery practices to be moved so that there is more commute time available to get to Heavy Combat practices for participants who might like to do both. We have moved the missile practices both an hour earlier starting September 5th, and the Heavy Combat practice is being moved back an hour.

Thrown Weapons – Athelina Grey 2019-05-07

Greetings! There's lots to report in thrown weapons!

We've been averaging 6 people at thrown practices! Lots of new throwers, some folks keen to learn marshaling. Adalwolf has expressed interest in working towards his Sr TWM over the next year or so! He also made us some new target stands and we got to test them out! Thank you!

We've been throwing and submitting scores for the Thrown Weapons Interkingdom Competition. This competition is Society-wide, and lets throwers focus on one type of throwing weapon (like archers can pick a bow type for RR's/ IKAC for each time they do it).

The SCA scores site crashed and passwords have to be reset: if you're a marshal who inputs scores, you'll need to reset your password if you haven't yet.

Interkingdom discussion on a universal format for a Royal Round is continuing: currently the many-kingdom development committee has agreed on a format, and it's now being reviewed by kingdom thrown weapons marshals to see which

kingdoms want to adopt it. It would be a big change for An Tir: currently most other kingdoms have Thrown Weapons Royal Rounds that only have a few throws at ten feet, but then also a few throws at other farther distances too. Many other kingdoms have formats where throwers pick a weapon type and use that for their royal round (and then could do another with a different weapon later if they want, but it's not mix and match). An Tir's TW Royal Round format currently requires throwers to throw a huge 60 times in a row: 20 with each of knife, axe, and spear, all at 10 feet. This can be prohibitive in several ways: throwers need all three weapons (and we can't share right now in Tir Righ), the range needs all the target types, and throwers have to throw 60 times (plus warm up in any/all weapons before they start, as warm ups are not allowed in between while scoring) which can be really inaccessible. Most of the other kingdoms are shocked at how "hardcore" the RR's for throwing are in An Tir. It'll be interesting to see if An Tir chooses to adopt the proposed universal format, which would allow throwers from all kingdoms to have a standard for measuring progress and prowess. (I mean... there is the TWIC already... but I think a lot of places forget that tournament type exists?) The addition of 15' and 20' for axe and knife throwing is a fun challenge so far! (We're doing those distances in addition to 10', expanding our skills!)

We have moved thrown/archery an hour earlier to give folks more time to get to the Duncan fight practice which I believe was going to move a bit later to reduce overlap in times. At this time, we do not have enough resources to run archery and thrown at the same time, but we're considering ways to move towards that in the next year or two if possible.

Also an axe handle broke, but that is super normal - no incident, no injuries, rather like breaking an arrow.

Whee!

Oh! Also we had an event. Right.

Please see attached MIC report for that. We threw at snails. Several new folks helped defeat the invading snail army! And Lord Dankvart killed the most snails!

Yay!

As many of you are aware we have a disagreement that has caused quite a divide in our Barony. We both believe the solution starts with everyone taking a step back and understanding that both words and actions towards each other are hugely impactful and it's important that we all handle disagreements with grace and kindness.

We have many people who serve and freely give of their time to Seagirt and we are strong because of them. We work together and play together and it's heartbreaking to both of us that factions are drawn and terms such as "gatekeeping" are being used, in our Barony and Principality, to describe the divisive situation over the targets.

To move forward together, we need to stop speaking negatively about each other. We need to try and understand where both sides are coming from, a desire to beautify and improve the game and concern that this will financially overextend the Baronies coffers. We believe that both sides are attempt to express themselves with the best of intentions but frustration can sometimes bring out words that are hurtful.

When new targets were made and donated to the archery community in an effort to be supportive, the feedback received (not from the Baronial Archer) was that it appeared to be undermining of the office. It was never the intention, and at the heart of it, intention is very important to consider in whatever actions someone undertakes.

We want to believe that everyone here has the good of the Barony at the core of their intentions and we need to work together to understand each other when we don't agree. We need impassioned people, for sure, but if we let that passion get ahead of our obligation to be kind to each other, we are lost. We need to look at all members' intentions with understanding and lifting each other up. We all share very similar interests and it should be easy enough to find common ground.

Kingdom has looked at our finances at the request of our exchequer and they have stated that, "... (they) are concerned about the amount that the expense will reduce (y)our operating funds..." and they have advised us to consider the expense and defer this investment, at least until events start up again and income starts flowing.
